On Thursday the weather was a bit warm and windy but that much sunshine.

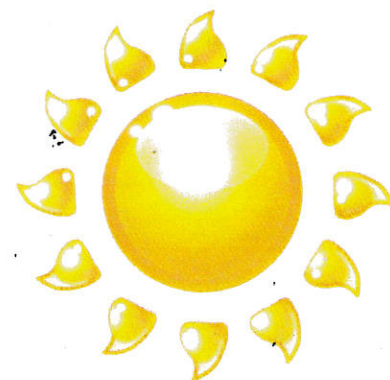
On Friday which was world book day the weather was a bit hot On Sunday it was a bit wet and a little bit of sunshine.

On Monday the weather was a sunny day but a bit cloudy.

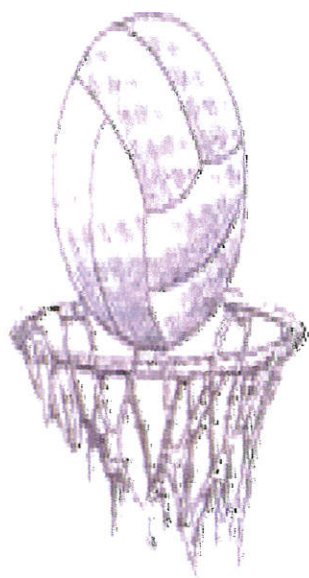
On Tuesday the weather was really sunny and a lot of sunshine.
